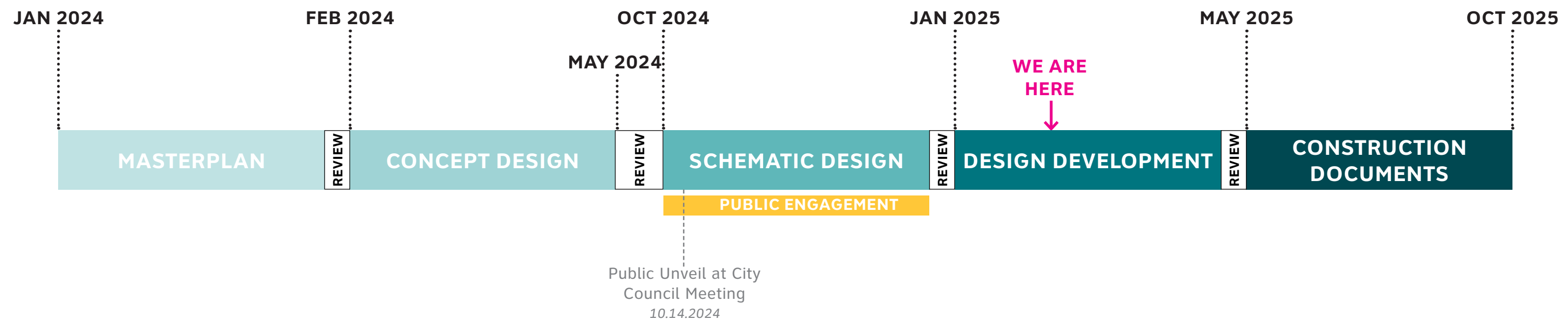

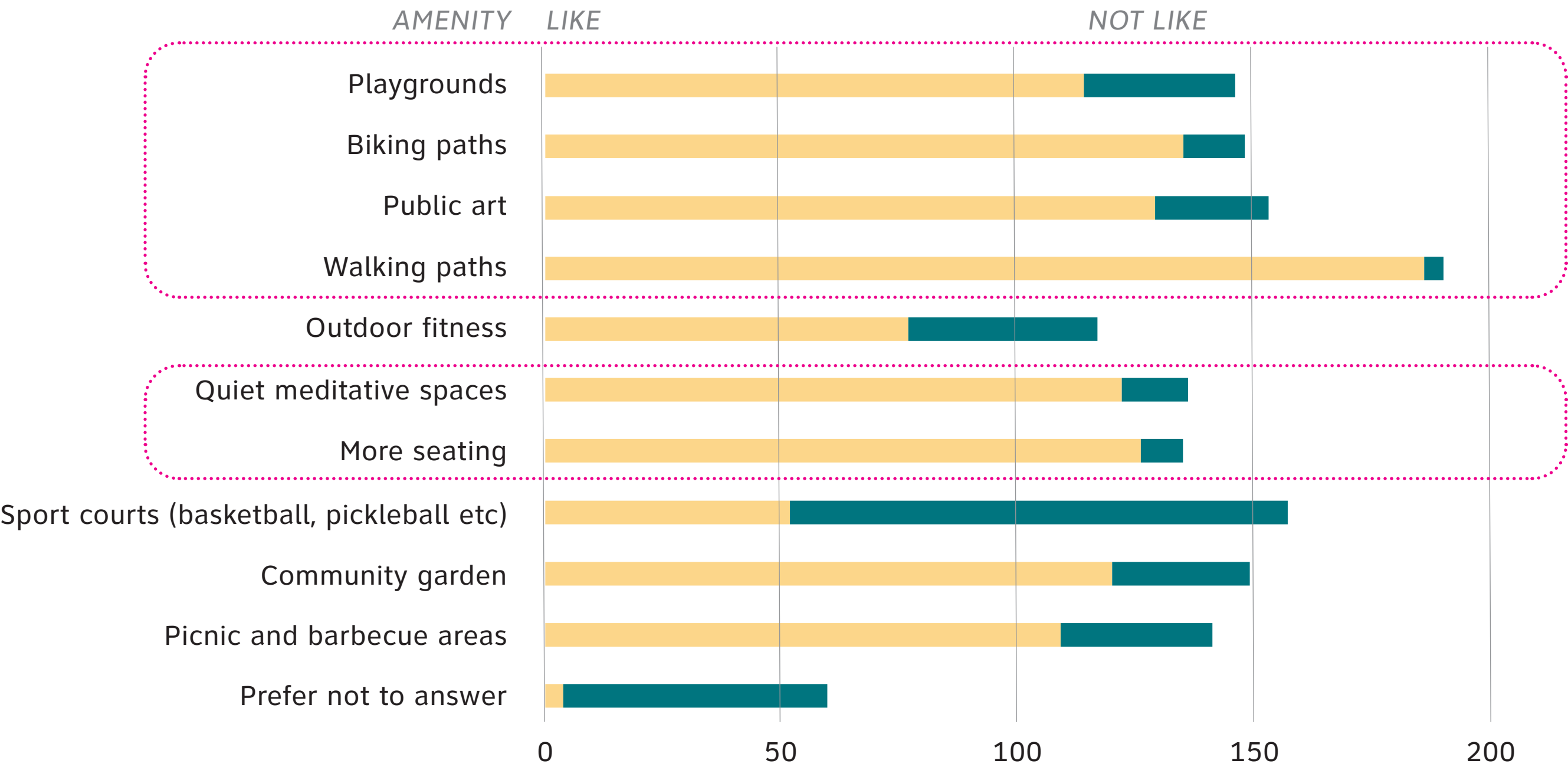

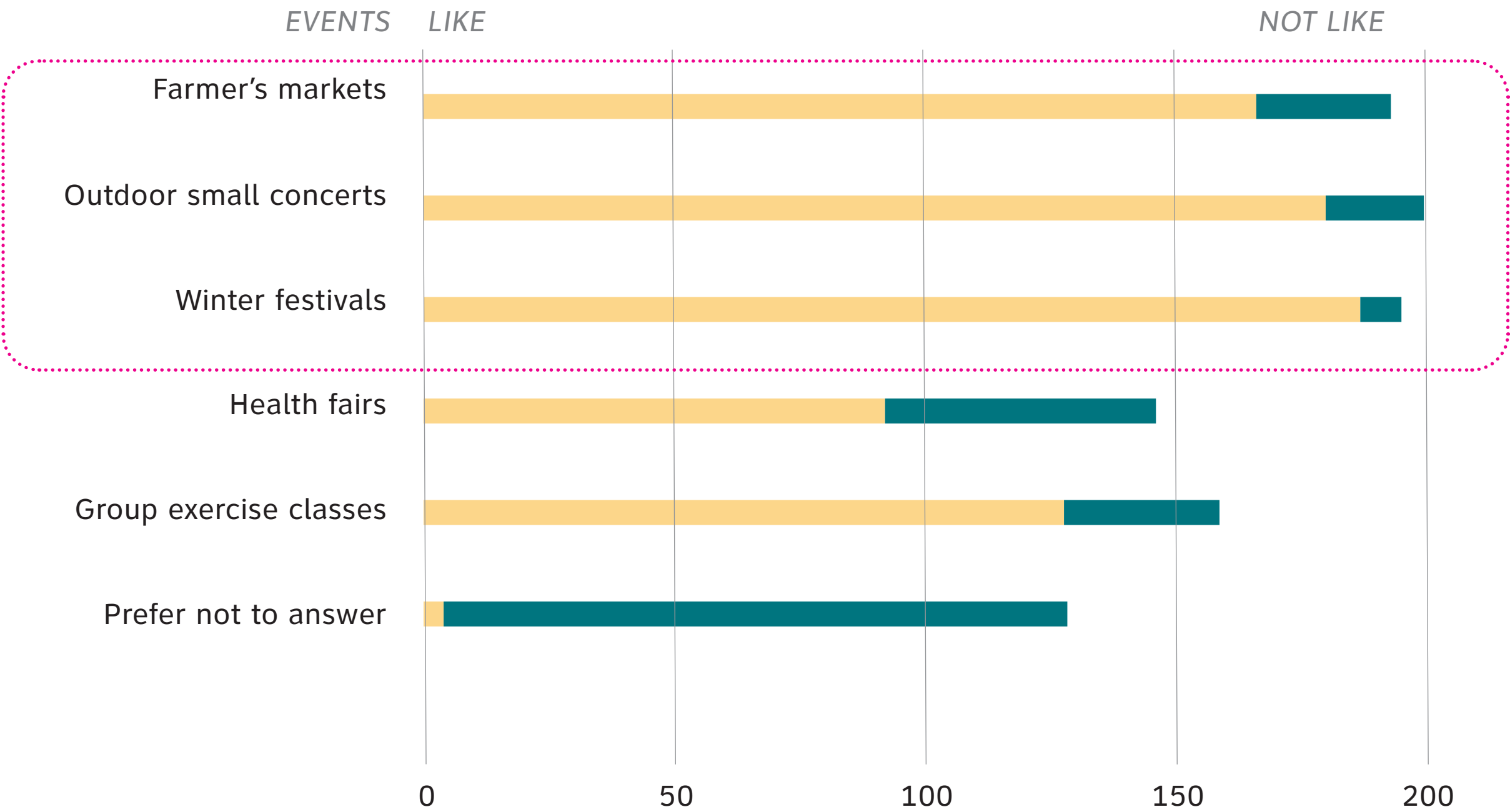
STAND OUT

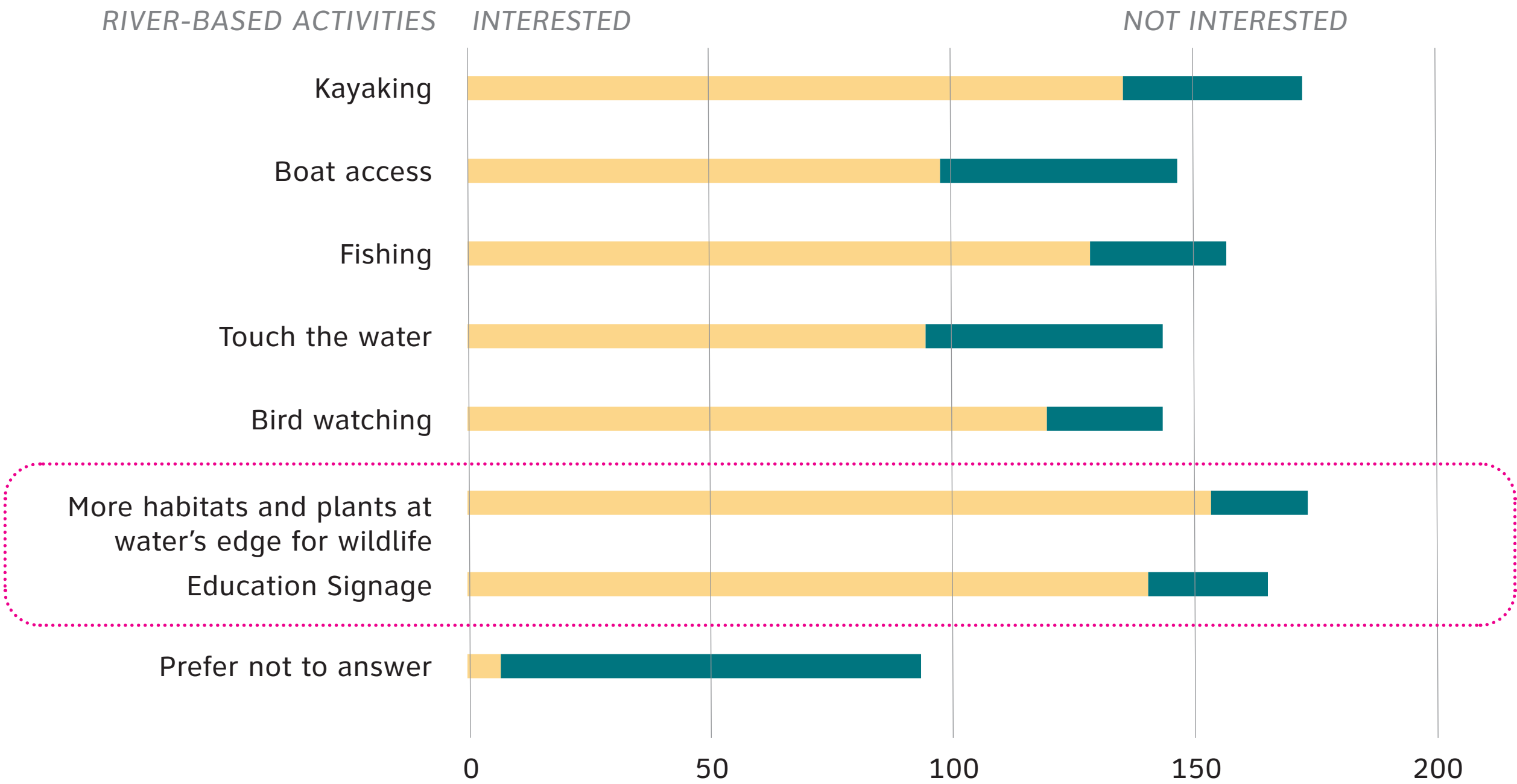

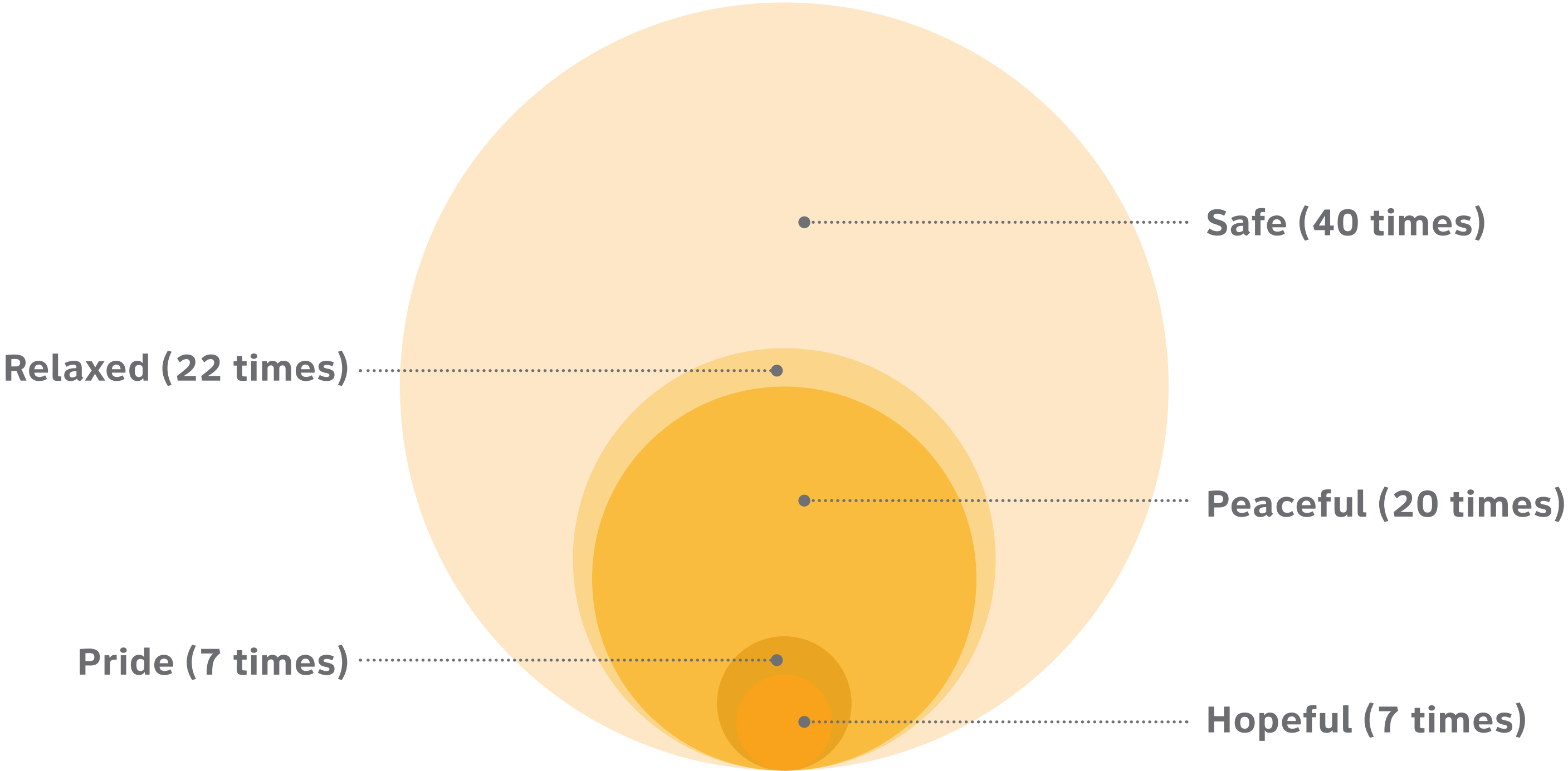

PROGRAMMING + COMMUNITY

INCREASE WATERFRONT ACCESS

"Access to the waterfront, variety of choices that appeal to both passive and active interests. Functional and effective arrangement of spaces."

"Incorporate more habitat and interpretive signage about river habitats and nature."

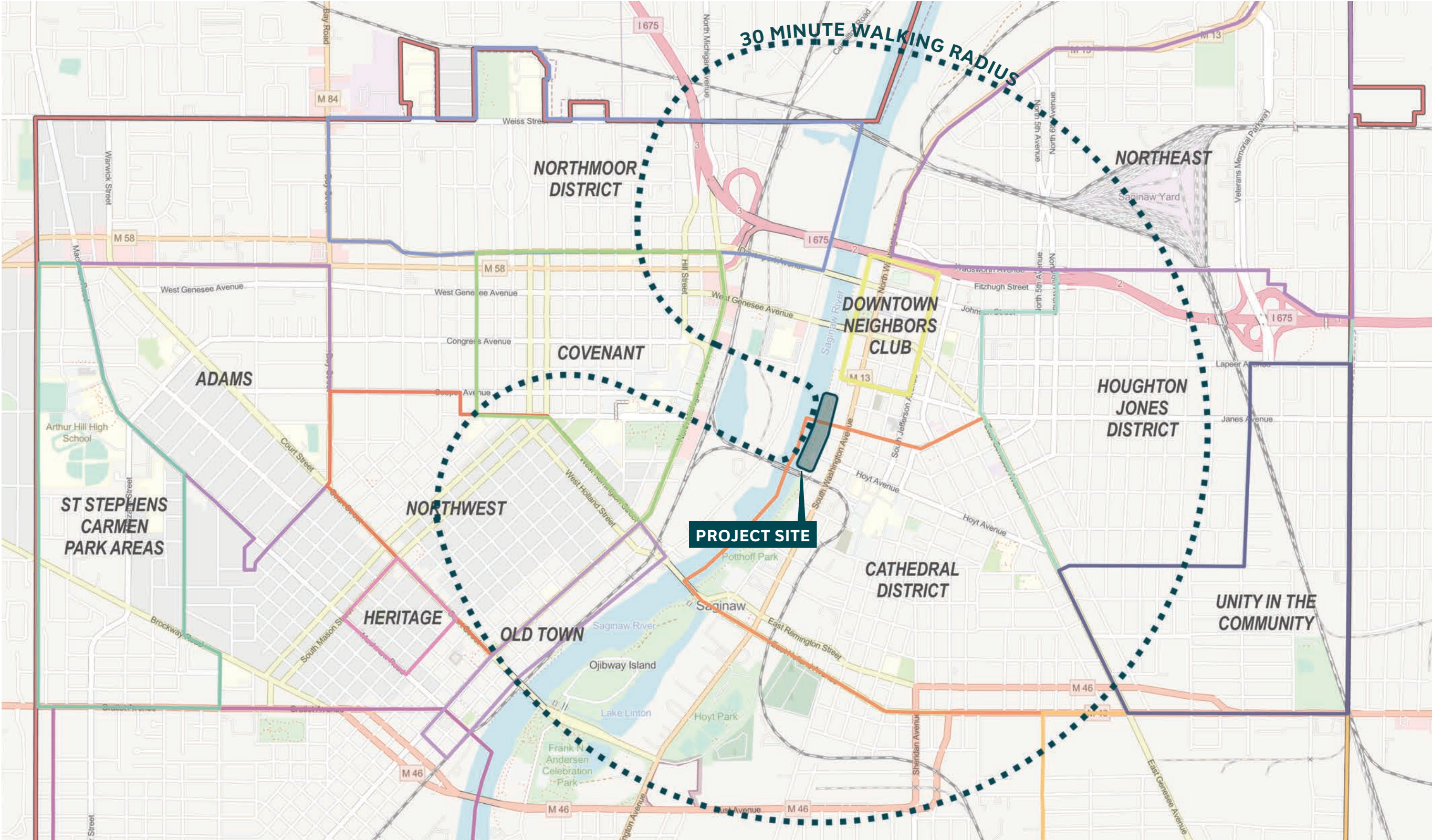

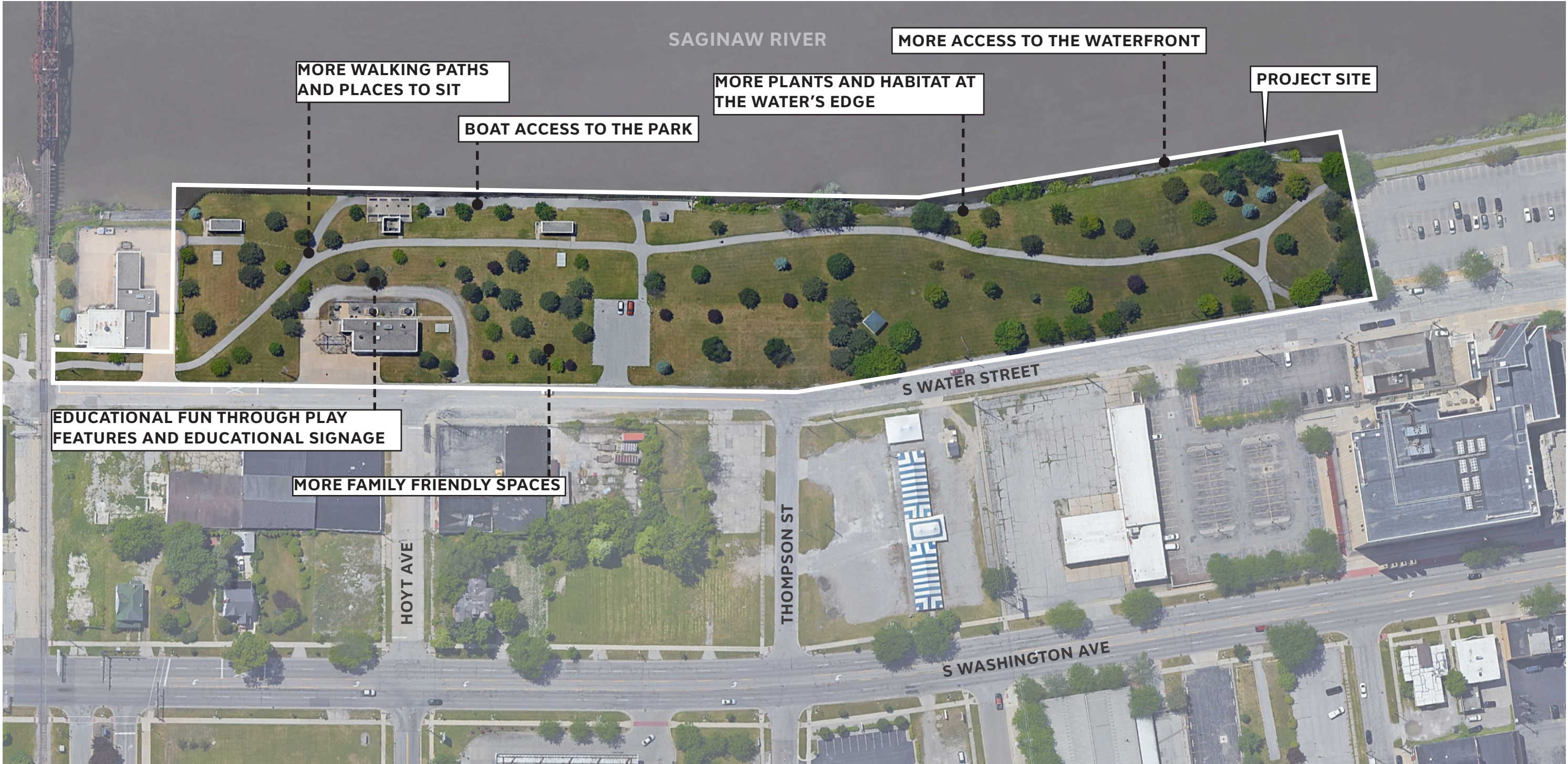

PARK LOCATION

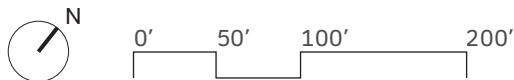

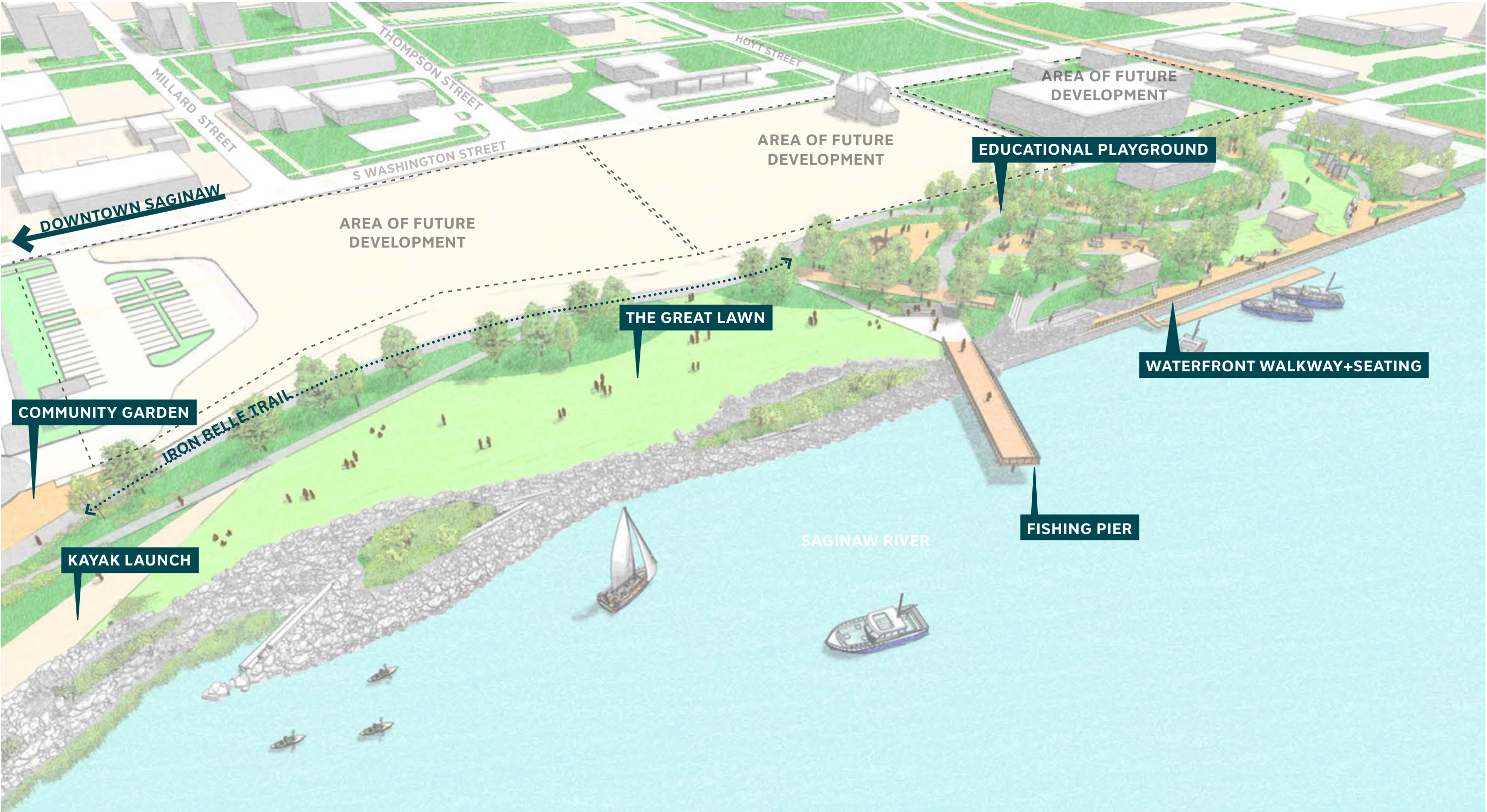

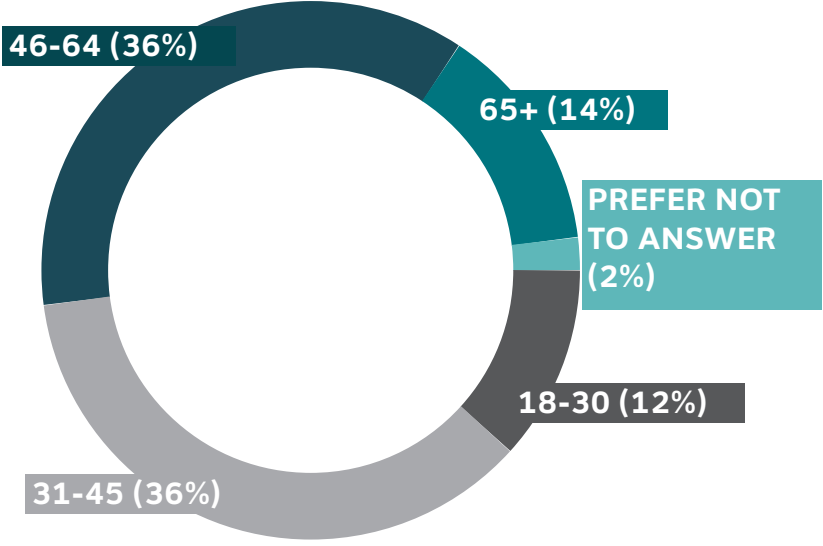

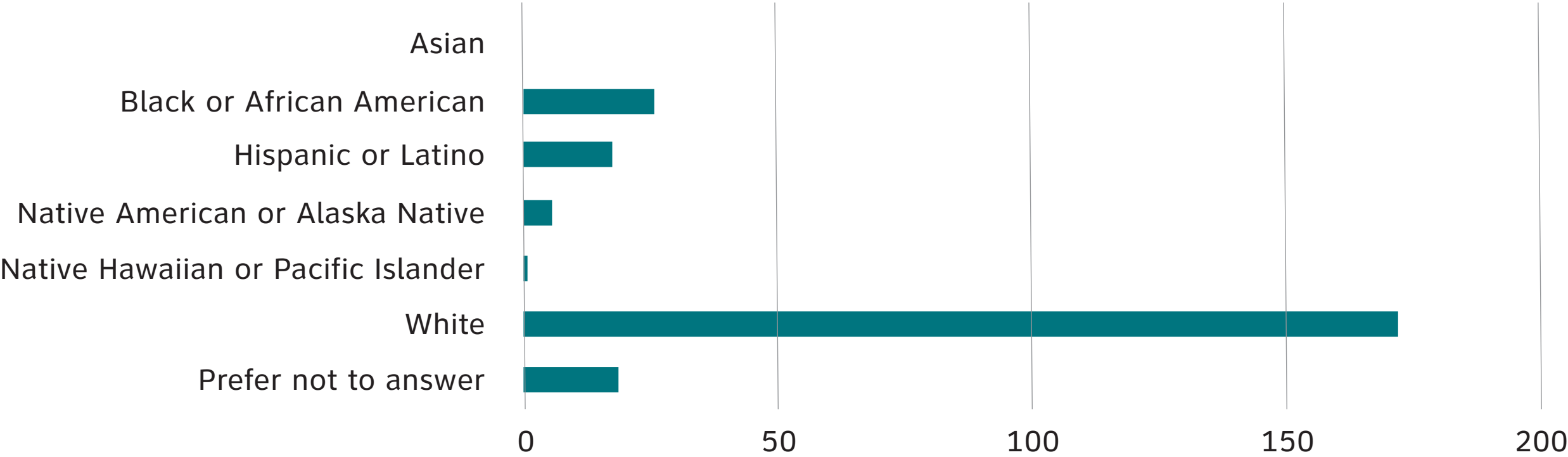
Which of the following genders do you identify with?



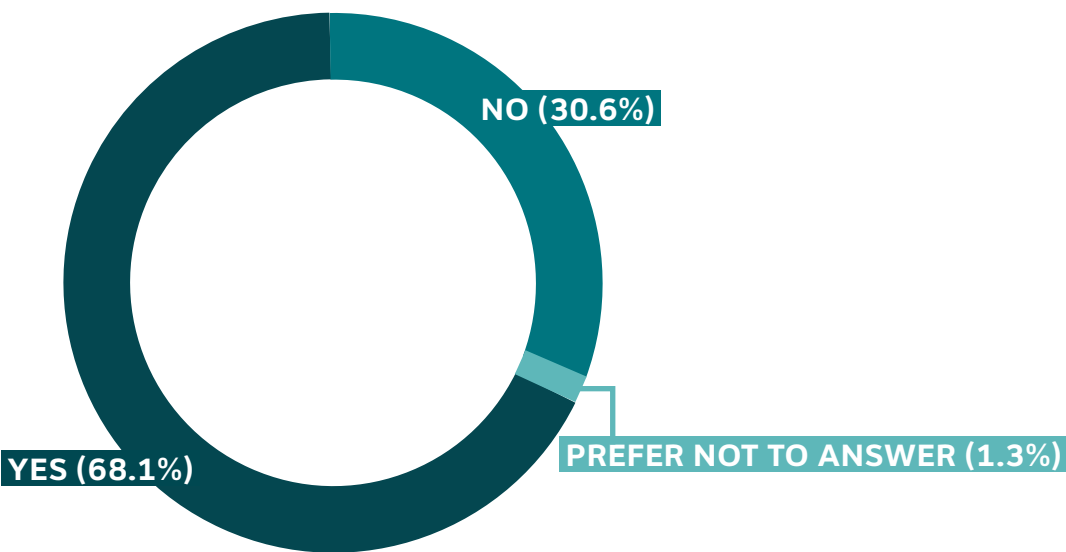

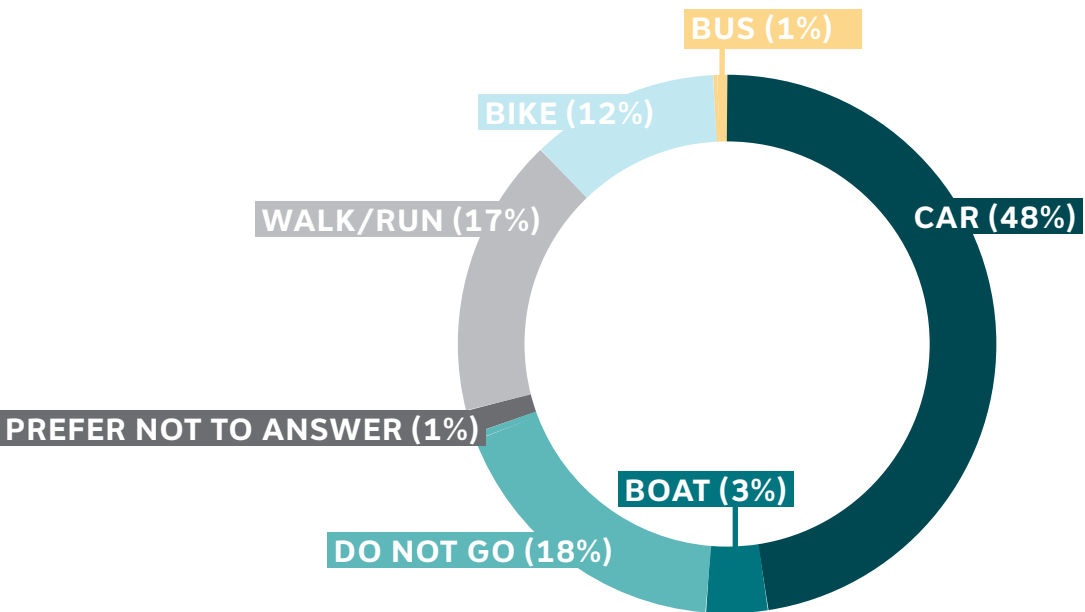

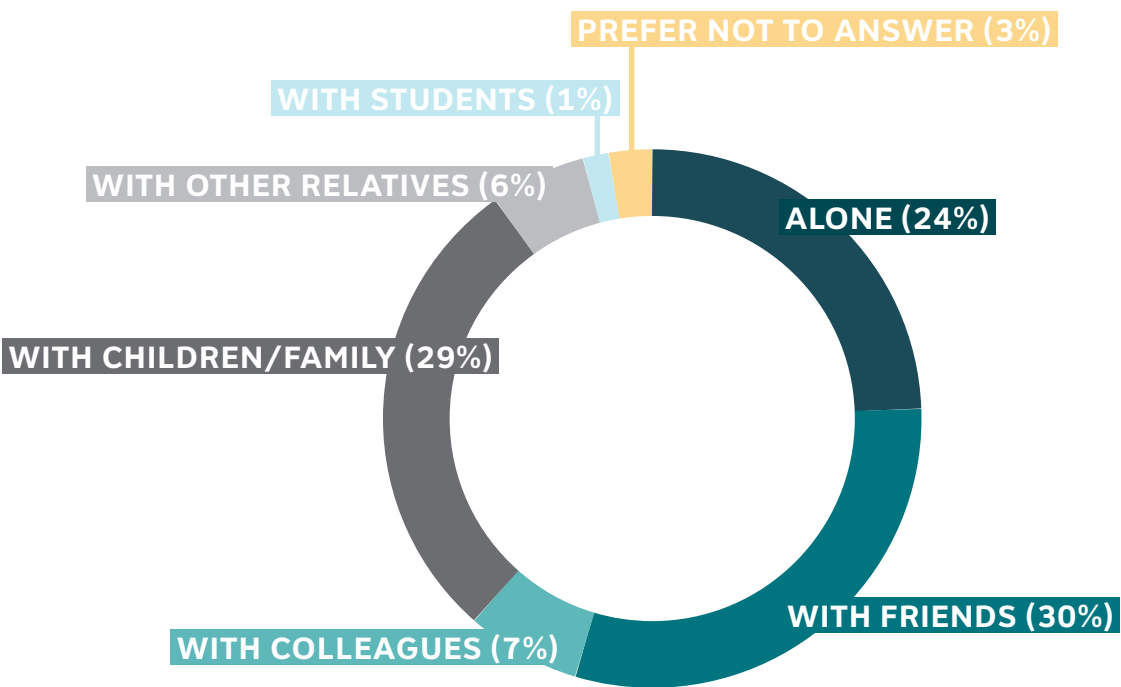

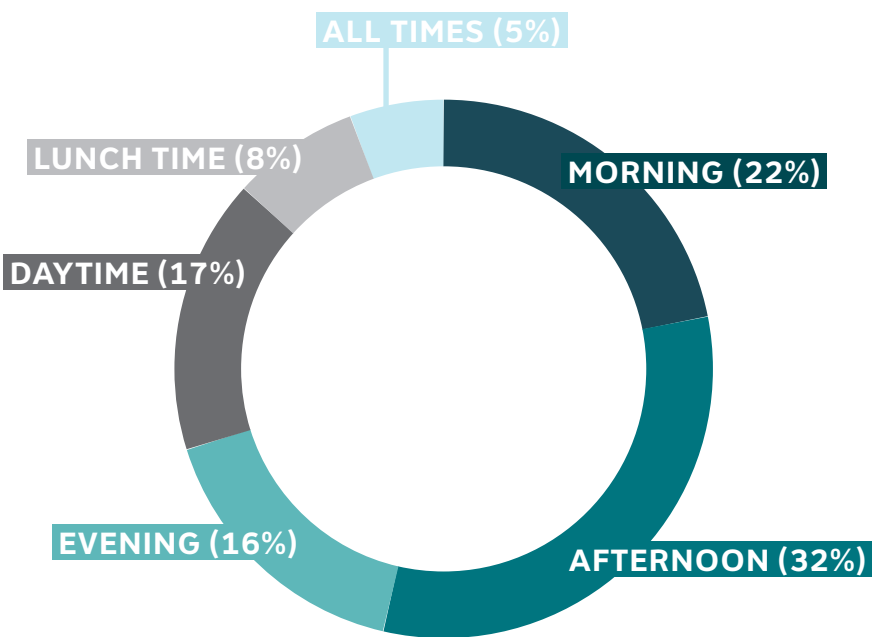
If you do, how do you get there?

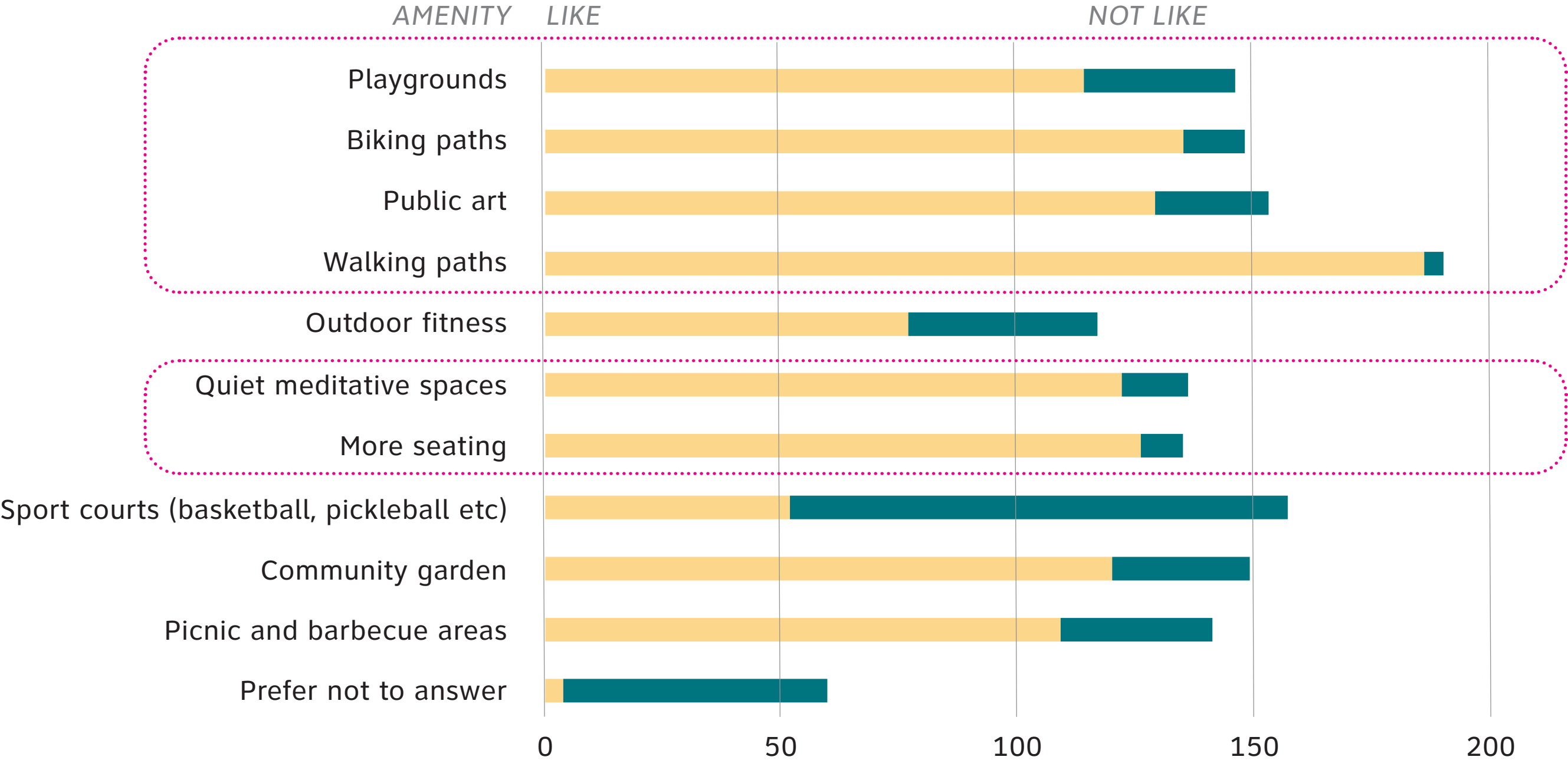

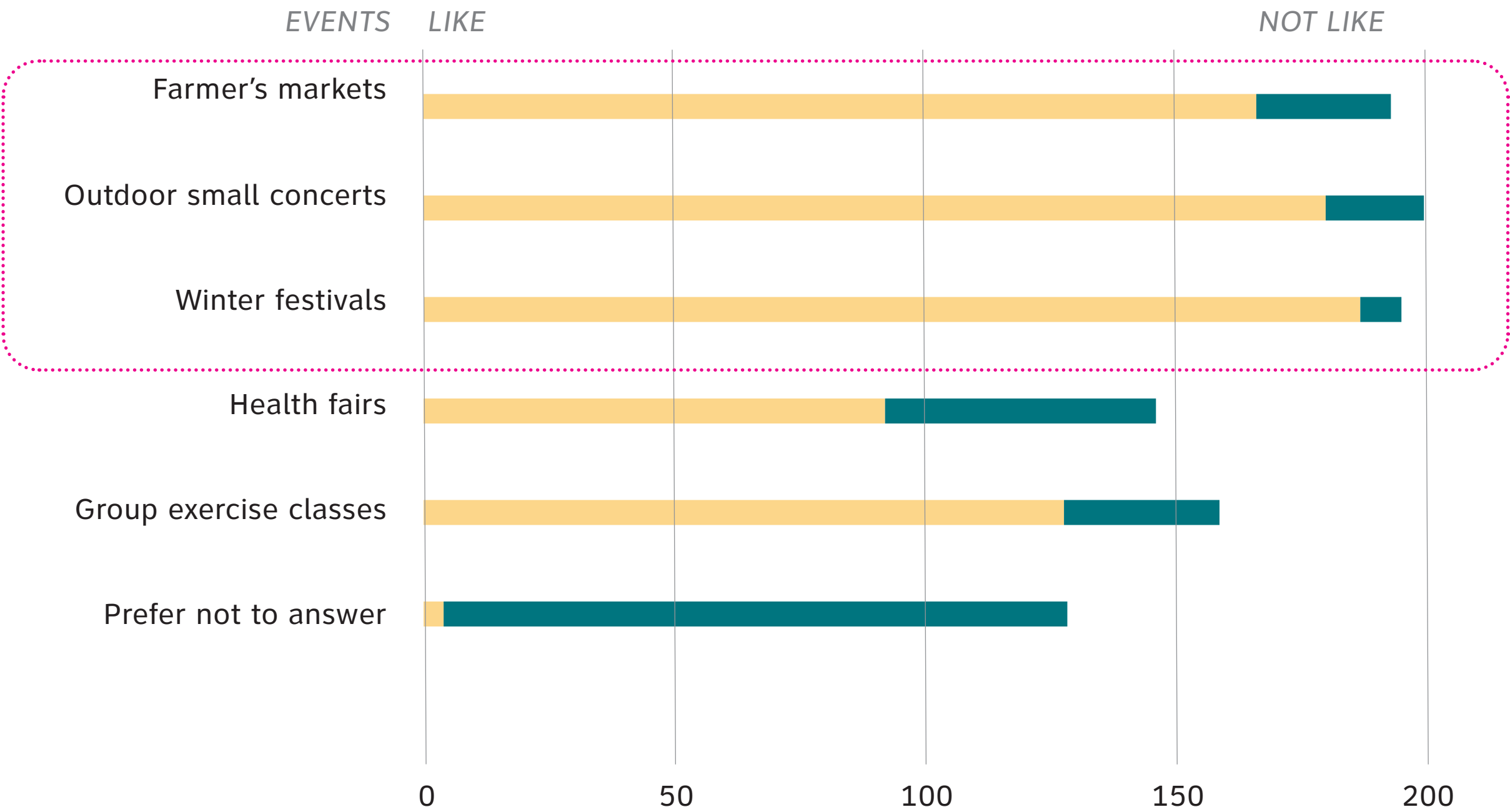

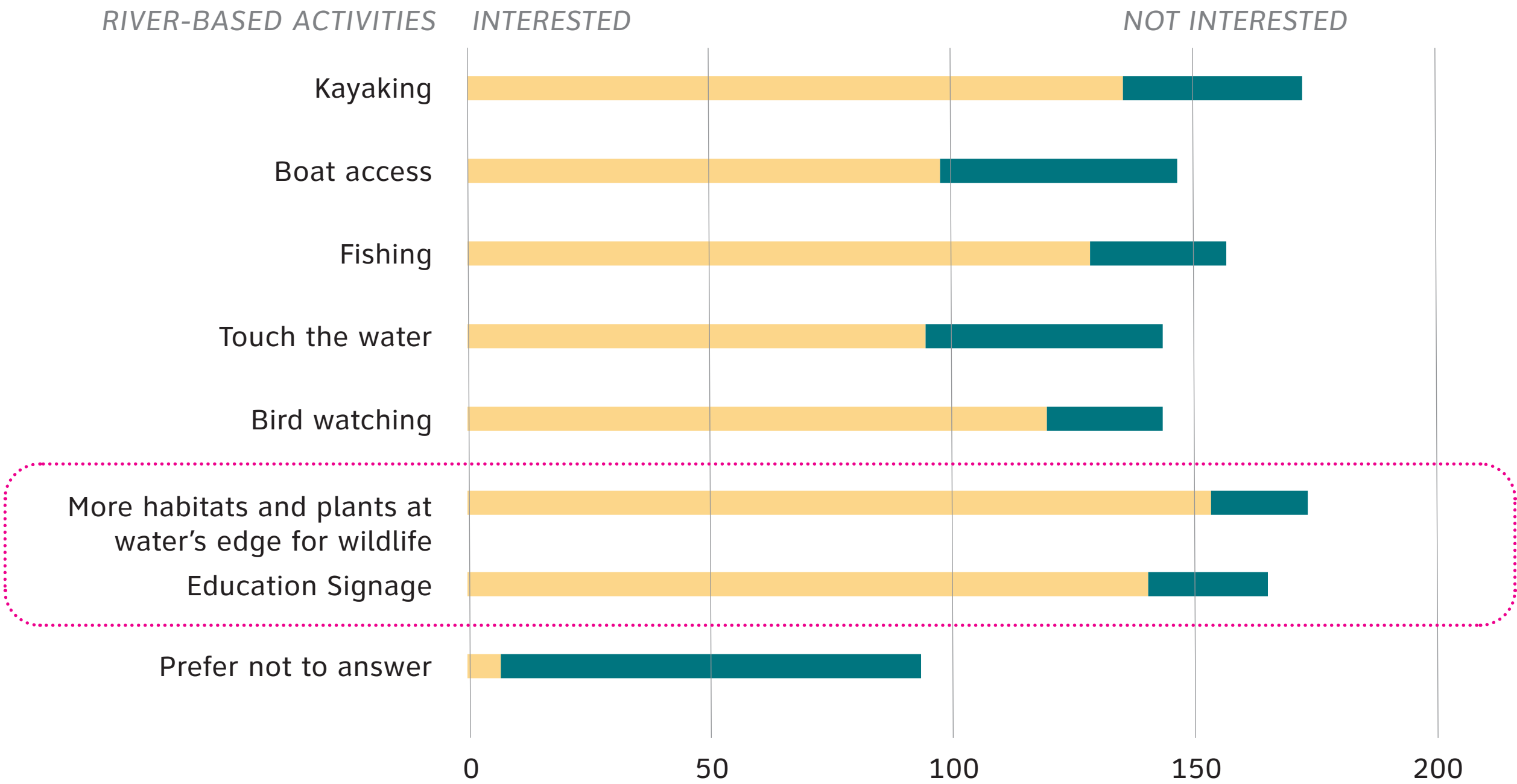

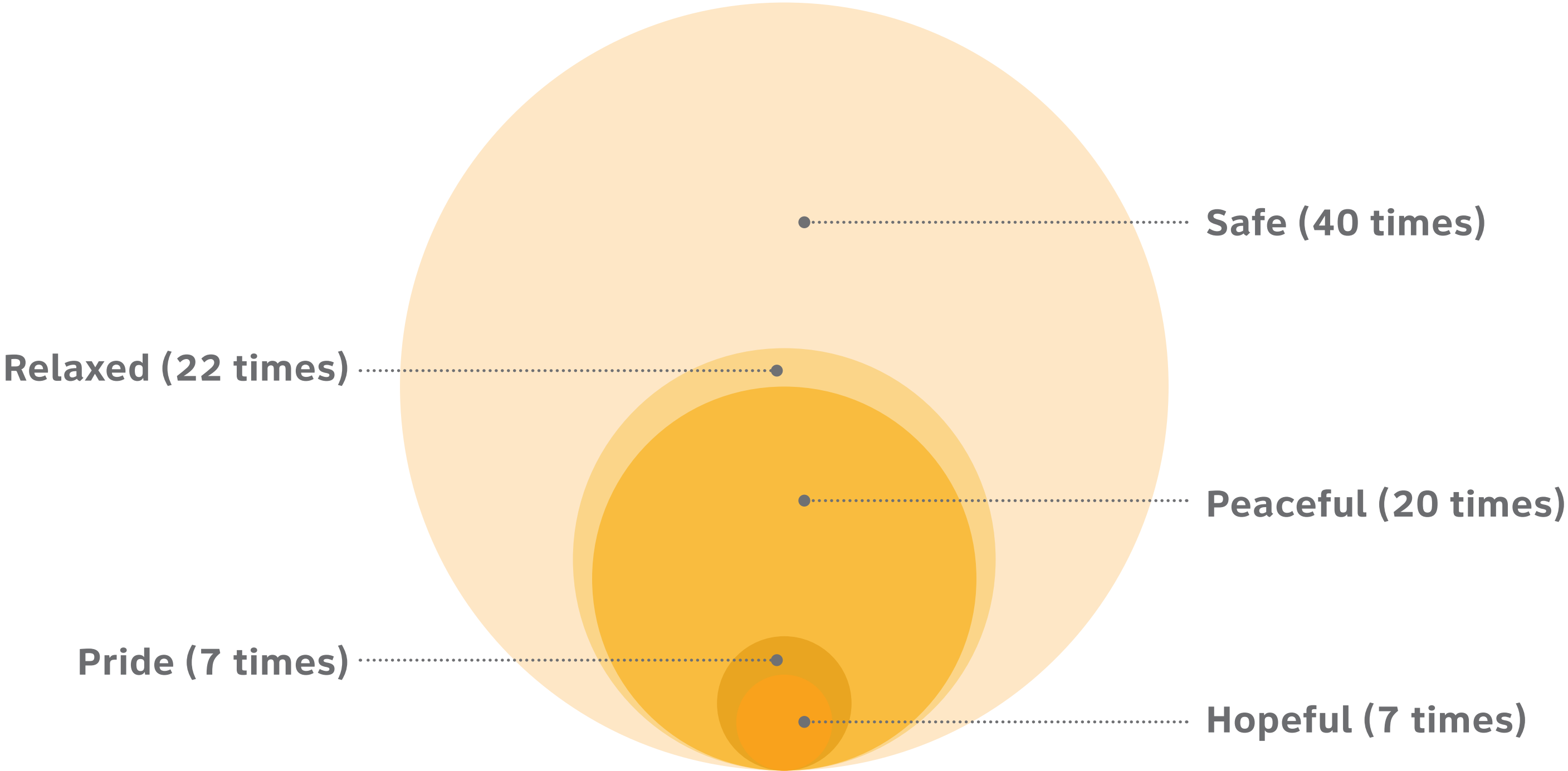

"Add sister-city signage to create a monuments or people to visit and increase education."

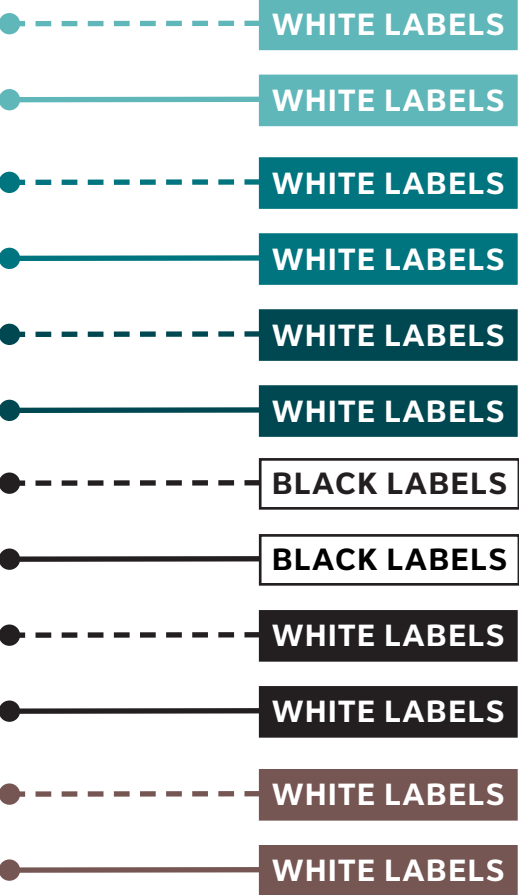
"I think that "educational fun" things can really enhance a park for all ages. Like, a playground that can have connections to the city's history, or something that teaches kids about music while also something to do for fun. Small Park on the riverfront in Cincinnati does this really well."

"I don't want it to feel suburban. It must feel like it is part of the urban core, unlike Uptown Bay City, which is completely isolated from the core and why I don't bother going there as it is not walkable. Buildings need to be adjacent to the sidewalk, not set back like in suburbs."

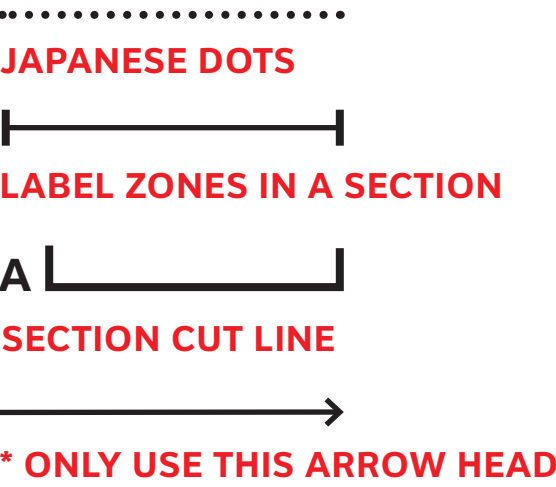
